## **House Hunting Checklist**





## View houses with a critical eye and think about:

Location and Travel	Communal Areas
Are you close to University/ shops/ public transport?	Are all shared rooms heated/ventilated/double glazed?
Is there space for secure bike storage?	Are there enough bathrooms/ toilets for your group?
Safety  Deer the house neighbourhood look	<ul><li>Is the kitchen big enough?</li><li>Is there enough kitchen storage? (fridges, cupboards and countertops)</li></ul>
Does the house, neighbourhood look in a good state of repair?  Are windows and doors secure?	Are communal rooms supplied furnished or unfurnished?
Smoke and Carbon monoxide detectors throughout the house?	Any signs of damp or mould?
<ul> <li>Is there a safe route to the main door should there be a fire (from all rooms)?</li> <li>Do sofas/ armchairs have fire safe labels?</li> </ul>	☐ Is the garden clear of waste?  Ask the Landlord/ Agent ☐ Are they registered with Rent Smart Wales?
Bedrooms  Is there space to study and relax?  Is there enough storage?  Is the room heated and ventilated?  Are windows double glazed?  Does it come furnished or unfurnished?  Any signs of damp/ mould?	Does the property have a licence if required?  Have they provided the annual Gas Safety Certificate?  Have they provided the Energy Performance Certificate?  Which mandatory deposit protection scheme is used?  What will you be asked to pay now? (Admin fees not permitted)

Take your time and find a home you love. Your landlord should give you 24 hours to take the contract away for an expert to check through it for 'unfair terms. If something doesn't feel right or if you would like a second opinion, free advice is available from your University Accommodation office or Student Union.
