# Think ahead!

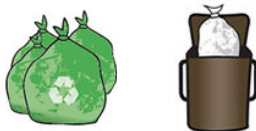
Put your recycling and waste out on your normal collection day. Make sure it is on the pavement no earlier than 4.30pm the evening before (Tuesday)- take all emptied bins/caddies/sacks back onto the property by 9am Thursday

## Collection dates in Cathays/Gabalfa/Penylan

9th May\*, 22nd May, 5th June, 19th June

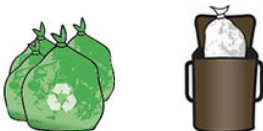


15th May, 30th May\*, 12th June, 26th June



## Collection dates in Roath (Plasnewydd)

9th May\*, 22nd May, 5th June, 19th June

\*Bank Holiday- collection 1 day later

### Need a reminder? Download the app!

The council have developed an app to help you never miss a waste collection.

You can even report in fly-tipping. Just search for "Cardiff Gov" in the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.



Don't forget, there are lots of ways you can recycle the waste you produce during your move out. You can recycle many items in your normal kerbside recycling collections and can put out as much recycling as you need to. Recycling bags are free, and you can pick them up at lots of places. ## Bulky waste collections

**DID YOU KNOW:** The Council can also offer a free household collection for many large item/s e.g. fridges, large electrical appliances.

The collection needs to be arranged in advance by contacting Connect to Cardiff on (029) 2087 2087

## Household Waste Recycling Centres

You can also dispose of recycling and waste for free, at a Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC). Before you pack your car to leave, why not take a trip to the HWRC to recycle the last of your items?

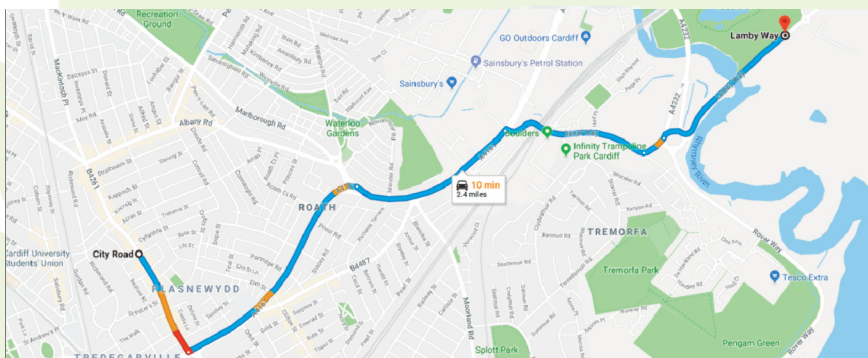
You can find skips for over 20 different materials- find out the full material list at [www.cardiff.gov.uk/HWRC](http://www.cardiff.gov.uk/HWRC)

If you need to use a van, this must be booked in advance and can only be accepted at Bessemer Close HWRC.

Please make sure you sort all of your waste before visiting the HWRC- you will be asked to separate all materials into the correct skip. You'll also need to bring some proof of living in Cardiff- your tenancy agreement will be fine, or a recent utility bill.

## Arrange an additional collection

The Council is also able to offer a one-off collection of waste, any day of the week. It must be arranged in advance, and it will be at a charge.
